

Women for a Healthy Environment (WHE) is a recipient of a Healthy Homes Grant from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The goal of the program supported by the grant is to help improve the health of children with a diagnosis of asthma by improving the health of their home environments. WHE will identify and enroll homes within Allegheny County in the program to deliver interventions proven to improve the health outcomes of children residing in homes with an asthma diagnosis. These interventions will include home improvements targeted at reducing exposure to triggers and allergens. Concurrent activities will include educating families about green cleaning, ways to manage asthma, and existing community resources. WHE is publishing a notice of intent to request the release of funds and is allowing a period for public comment. Notices will be posted in libraries, government offices, post offices, and on our website.
