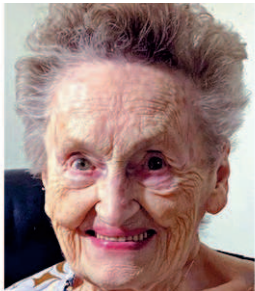


MARY (MINDAS) CMAR
