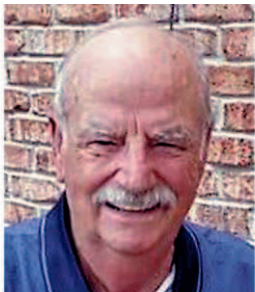


## **BERNARD "BERNIE" YOUNG**
