

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON

Hanbury a/k/a Thomas Willaim Hanbury, parents of **Ariella Samantha Hanbury a/k/a Ariella Hanbury**, a female minor born on October 29, 2011, in Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.

A Petition has been filed asking the court to put an end to all rights you have to your child, **Ariella Samantha Hanbury a/k/a Ariella Hanbury**. The court has set a hearing to consider ending your rights to your child. That hearing will be held at **The Family Court Building, 550 Fifth Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15219** on **Tuesday, June 27, 2023, at 9:30 a.m., prevailing time, before the Honorable Paul E. Cozza**. You are warned that even if you fail to participate in the scheduled hearing, the hearing will go on without you and your rights to your child may be ended by the court without your being present. You have a right to be represented at the hearing by a lawyer. You should contact your lawyer at once. If you do not have a lawyer or cannot afford one, go to or telephone the office set forth below to find out where you can get legal help.

This is to inform you of an important option that may be available to you under Pennsylvania law. Act 101 of 2010 allows for an enforceable voluntary agreement for continuing contact or communication following an adoption between an adoptive parent, a child, a birth parent, and/or a birth relative of the child, if all parties agree and the voluntary agreement is approved by the court.
