

## ROBERT C. "BOB" BIZUB



Robert C. "Bob" Bizub passed away on Monday, June 12, 2023. He came into this world as the 16th and final child of his mother Rozalia, and father, Jozef Bizub during the Great Depression. His childhood was challenging in many ways, especially due to poor health, but he always had the love of his mother, who cherished him. He also knew the love of God. He was a devout Roman Catholic,

having served as an altar server and eucharistic minister, including to people in the community. Bob was drafted during the Korean War but thankfully, the armistice happened three months into his tour. He served with the first atomic tank division of the U.S. Army and was grateful for the experience, especially for the G.I. Bill, which enabled him to get his B.A. in Education at Duquesne University. Eventually, he would complete his Master's and go on to a career in public school teaching. Bob taught Spanish, but mostly French for 33 years in both Shaker Heights, OH, and Tenafly, NJ. According to former students, he was an inspired and inspiring educator who touched the lives of many. Despite his humble beginnings, he was a cultured man who enjoyed music, art, and travel. He had a green thumb, and upon his retirement, he served as a docent at Phipps Conservatory, Pittsburgh's botanical garden. Most importantly, he was a devoted, hilarious, and loving father and husband. He is survived by his daughter Anne and his wife Bernice, as well as his last remaining sibling, Mrs. Frances Miketa, and numerous nieces, and nephews. He was a gift to this world and will be dearly missed.
