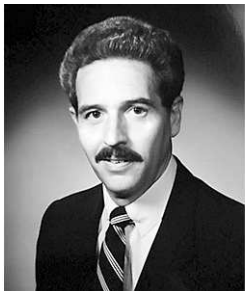


RICHARD HERMAN GUMTO
