The public bid opening will be held at the facility in the Lincoln Gallery immediately after bids are due.

A Certified check payable to the Andrew Carnegie Free Library & Music Hall or a bid bond executed by the Bidder and a surety company approved by the Owner, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of bid, must be submitted with each bid.
