General Notice

Bids are requested for the following Contract: Hay Street Reconstruction

Wilkinsburg Borough will receive sealed bids online for the Hays Street reconstruction in Wilkinsburg Borough. Bids may be submitted and will be received online using the PennBid online platform until Thursday, August 17, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. local time. At that time the Bids received will be opened electronically and publicly posted on the PennBid website.

The Project includes the following Work:

The existing roadway surface on Hay Street between Penn Avenue and the Pittsburgh Regional Transit Busway entrance/exit will be removed. The existing roadway base will be removed, and new roadway base installed along with a new brick roadway surface. Two ADA curb ramps will be installed at the intersection of Ross Ave and Hay Street. Alternatives include 1) removing existing and installing new storm water catch basins, 2) resurfacing a portion of Sawyer Avenue, and 3) installation of an underdrain trench are included.

Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the designated website. Prospective Bidders are urged to register with the designated website as a plan holder, even if Bidding Documents are obtained from a plan room or source other than the designated website in either electronic or paper format. The designated website will be updated periodically with addenda, lists of registered plan holders, reports, and other information relevant to submitting a Bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered only through the designated website. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated website.

Instructions to Bidders.

Bid security in the form a Certified Check or Bid Bond shall be furnished with the bid in an amount not less than 10%.

All questions about the meaning or intent of the Bidding Documents are to be submitted via PennBID in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Telephone inquiries are unacceptable.

For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

Statutory Requirements.

Bidders must comply with all State antibid-rigging regulations pertaining to work associated with this project, and will be required to submit an executed non-collusion affidavit with the bid.

Bidders should refer to provisions of federal and state statutes, rules and regulations dealing with the prevention of environmental pollution and preservation of public natural resources that affect the project, pursuant to Act No. 247 of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved October 26, 1972.

This Project falls under The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania enacted Act 127 of 2012, known as the Public Works Employment Verification Act ('the Act') which requires all public work contractors and subcontractors to utilize the Federal Government's E-Verify system to ensure that all employees performing work on public work projects are authorized to work in the United States. All Bidders are required to submit a Public Works Employment Verification Form as a precondition for the Contract Award.

The estimated cost for each Contract is greater than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) and the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act shall apply.

The Borough of Wilkinsburg reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any bid or combination of bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of the Borough of Wilkinsburg, and to reject any or all proposals.
