Authority in an amount equal
to ten percent (10%) of the
Proposal as a guarantee that,
if the Proposal is accepted, the
successful Bidder will
immediately enter into
Agreement after the Notice of
Award of the Contract and
commence start of
construction once the dated
Notice to Proceed has be
