This project involves three separate and distinct contracts for infrastructure improvements on Nelson Run Road, including, but not limited to the replacement of an existing bridge with elliptical reinforced concrete pipe; the replacement of an existing bridge with galvanized corrugated metal pipe; the reinforcement of the slope along the Nelson Run stream; as well as traffic control; asphalt replacement; shielding and shoring; utility coordination; sanitary sewer pipe and manhole installation; concrete structure installation; erosion and sedimentation control; and restoration.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the Contract Number in the lower left corner and bearing the words **ROSS TOWNSHIP – NELSON RUN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS, RE-BID CONTRACT 7/2023** to the Ross Township Department of Public Works Building located 225 Cemetery Ln, Pittsburgh, PA 15237.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided. Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Ross Township in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

**Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Rates must be paid on this contract.**

Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60-1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July, 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran Owned Small Businesses.

All contractors must adhere to Act 127 of 2012 (Public Works Employment Verification Act).

No bid may be withdrawn for sixty (60) days after the same has been filed with Ross Township. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any of all bids or to waive any informality in bids received.
