Sealed Bids will be received by the Town of McCandless, 9955 Grubs Road, Wexford, PA 15090, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania until **10:00 AM, September 8, 2023**, and the Bids will be publicly opened and read thereafter at the Town Hall at the same address for the following:

MTSA LITTLE PINE CREEK STREAM RESTORATION

This project consists of improvements to an existing stream and installation of in-stream structures, including log vanes, log deflectors, and a rock crossvane with a step pool, along with areas of bank stabilization, including branch layering, toe wood with branch layering, and gravel bar and debris removal. The project also includes the removal of chain link fence and installation of a chain link gate; installation, maintenance, and removal of sediment control devices; landscaping; and all associated site restoration to be completed in place. All Proposals must be in the hands of Brian O'Malley, Town Manager, before 10:00 AM prevailing time, September 8, 2023 at the Town Building, 9955 Grubbs Road, Wexford, PA 15090 and the same will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words, **MTSA LITTLE PINE CREEK STREAM RESTORATION**.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on August 24, 2023 at 2:00 PM at 1275 Hazlett Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15237.

Pennsylvania Prevailing wage rates MUST be paid on this Contract. Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreements are available at Gateway Engineers, Inc. 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205 for \$25.00 each. No refunds will be made to documents purchased. A \$10.00 mailing fee will be applied if a Contractor requests that documents be mailed. Electronic copies will be available free of charge. Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder. Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Town of McCandless in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract. If more time is necessary for the ascertainment of the lowest responsible bidder, the Town reserves the right to award the contract at a later date, but not exceeding sixty (60) days from the date bids were submitted, and such date will be publicly announced immediately after the bids are opened. The Bidder is advised that the Town will award the contract to the best responsible bidder based on the total bid submitted and natural stream channel restoration verification. However, the bidder is advised that the Town expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, or any part thereof, for any reason, and also reserves the right to waive any informality therein, and specifically reserves the right to award to the best responsible bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each item listed and the unit price bid for each item listed.
