prevailing time. All proposals must be clearly marked with the name of the project as it appears above. This contract shall be subject to the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of August 15, 1961, P.L. 987, as amended 43 P.S. section 165 et. Seq. Workers shall not be paid less than the prevailing minimum wages as set forth in applicable schedule. All bidders must submit a bid bond in the form of a certified check, bank cashier's check, or other form of negotiable instrument which is guaranteed by a commercial bank. Bid bond must be drawn to the order of the City of Duquesne in the sum of 10% of the bid and must be submitted with the proposal. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any form of a bid bond which, in the sole opinion of the City, does not provide sufficient security for the bid. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any portion of any bid, waiver informality or irregularity of any bid or in the bidding and/or negotiate with the receipt of bids. The City reserves the right to increase or decrease any or all quantities. No bid will be accepted after the time herein specified whether or not the bidder has a time other than the official City time. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.
