

Public Notice: Former Beazer East, Inc. Facility - Bridgeville, PA

PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE:
The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed remedy of Corrective Action Complete with Controls under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (RCRA), for the Former Beazer East Inc. facility (Facility).

Summary of Proposed Action:
RCRA Corrective Action - Cleanup Proposal

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Facility is located at 3001 Presto Sygan Road, Bridgeville, PA 15017. The Facility is approximately 301 acres of which 55 acres comprise of the former manufacturing facility. Historical manufacturing processes included the production of chlorinated naphthalene, amino and alkyd resins, resole resins, maleic anhydride, and phthalic anhydride.

COMMENT PROCESS: Persons to comment on EPA's proposed decision must submit comments to EPA within the 30-day comment period ending 9/9/2023. Interested persons may also request a public hearing on this proposed remedy. All comments and/or requests for a hearing must be submitted in writing via mail, fax, or email to the EPA Project Manager, Khai Dao as listed above, and must be received prior to 9/9/2023. All comments will be considered in making a final decision.

FINAL DECISION: EPA will make a final decision after considering all comments, consistent with applicable RCRA requirements and regulations. If the remedy is substantially unchanged from the one in this notice, EPA will issue a final decision and inform all persons who submitted written comments or requested notice of EPA's final determination. If the remedy is significantly different from the one proposed, EPA will issue a public notice explaining the new remedy and will reopen the comment period.
