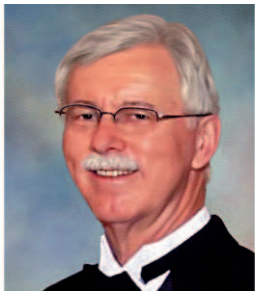


BRIAN PEARSON RHODES
