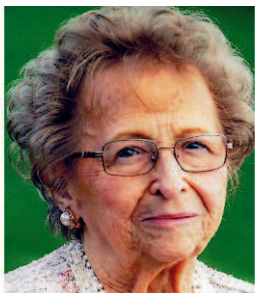


ANNA C. McNULTY
