The ACHD is seeking comments on the following draft permits. Copies of documents are open for public inspection by request at apermits@alleghenycounty.us or 412-578-8115. Written comments may be submitted to the Department at 301 39th Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15201 or by e-mail at apermits@alleghenycounty.us by the end of the day on Tuesday, September 26, 2023. A public hearing will be held regarding the proposed issuance of these permits on Tuesday, September 26, 2023, at 6 pm at the Clark Health Center, Building #7. Persons wishing to present testimony should register online at least 24 hours in advance of the hearing on the Department's permits webpage at <https://alleghenycounty.us/AQnotices>. If the hearing is canceled, the Department will provide public notice on the webpage or through the contact information listed above. Comments to previously issued installation or operating permits that are being modified will be accepted on the modified language only. Also where indicated, this is notice of final action by the Department of issuance, amendment, renewal, or denial of the subject permit. Appeals to final actions may be filed in accordance with Article XI of the County Health Department Regulations and the Pa. Local Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S.A. 101 et seq., 551 et seq., & 751 et seq., within 30 days of the date of publication of this notice to the Director, Allegheny County Health Department, 542 Fourth Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15219.

INTENT TO ISSUE OR MODIFY INSTALLATION PERMITS

911th AIRLIFT WING PITTSBURGH IAP/ARS (0868-1003a), 1100 Herman Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15108 to update the number of natural gas combustion units with Low-NOX burners from 8 units to 51 units and to remove an emergency generator. This update will result in the following potential change in emissions: 0.11 tons/yr of PM, 0.01 tons/yr of SOX, -3.02 tons/yr of NOX, 1.35 tons/yr of CO, 0.04 tons/yr of VOCs.

BUCKEYE PIPE LINE COMPANY, LP - CORAOPOLIS TERMINAL (0040-1005), 3324 University Blvd, Moon Township, PA 15108 for the installation of a new vapor recovery unit (VRU) to control VOC/HAP emissions at the loading rack. This installation will result in a decrease in potential emissions of VOCs and HAPs.

GOTTLIEB, INC. (0318-1002), 5603 Grand Avenue, Neville Township, PA 15225 for the installation of a rotary melting furnace, holding furnace and associated air pollution control equipment. This installation will result in the following potential emission changes: 8.92 tons/yr of PM, 1.60 tons/yr of SOX, 21.47 tons/yr of NOX, 1.86 tons/yr of CO, 8.79 tons/yr of VOCs, 0.88 tons/yr of HF, 0.88 tons/yr of HCl, and 6.6×10^{-7} tons/yr of D/F.

METALICO NEVILLE, INC. (0692-1002), 3100 Grand Avenue, Neville Twp., PA 15225 for the installation of a 0.5 MMBtu/hr waste oil-fired boiler. This installation will result in the following potential emission increases: 1.38 tons/yr of PM, 0.9 tons/yr of SOX, 0.34 tons/yr of NOX, 0.09 tons/yr of CO, 0.02 tons/yr of VOCs

INTENT TO ISSUE OR MODIFY MINOR/SYNTHETIC MINOR SOURCE OPERATING PERMITS

ALLEGHENY COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY - PITTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT LANDSIDE TERMINAL (0019-OP23), 4th Floor Mezzanine, Pittsburgh, PA 15231 for the renewal of a Synthetic Minor Source Operating Permit for an air transportation service. The facility is a synthetic minor source for nitrogen oxides.

KEYWELL METALS, LLC (0794-OP23), 890 Noble Drive, West Mifflin, PA 15122 for the issuance of a Minor Source Operating Permit for the operation of multiple scrap metal recycling processes that includes torch cutting, a burn-off oven, and a steel ring crusher.

METALICO NEVILLE, INC. (0692-OP23), 3100 Grand Avenue, Neville Twp., PA 15225 for the issuance of a Synthetic Minor Source Operating Permit for the operation of a scrap metal shredding operation. The draft permit incorporates consent order conditions for the minimization of VOC and visible emissions and limits on operation to maintain synthetic minor status.

PNC SMITHFIELD BOILER PLANT (0972-OP23), 500 Smithfield Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15222 for the issuance of a Minor Source Operating Permit for three boilers.

INTENT TO ISSUE MAJOR SOURCE (TITLE V) PERMITS
Under Article XXI, §2103.11.e. and §2103.21.c, notice is hereby given that the Allegheny County Health Department intends to issue a Title V Operating Permit to the following major facilities subject to the operating permit requirements under Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act and Article XXI, Part C, Subparts 1 and 2. The Administrator of the EPA is being notified of this proposed action.

HARSCO METALS (0370-OP23), Federal Street, Gate No. 10, Natrona Heights PA, 15065, for slag processing including pot dumping, cooling and truck loading for off-site shipment. The facility includes indoor slag pot dumping & cooling, lancing booths, and scrap handling. The facility is a minor source of all criteria pollutants and Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs), as defined in Article XXI. However, the facility is required to have a major source operating permit because it is a support facility for ATI Flat-Rolled Products.

LHT - NEVILLE ISLAND TERMINAL (0012-OP23), 2760 Neville Road, Neville Township, PA 15225 for the bulk storage and distribution terminal for gasoline, gasoline-ethanol blends, distillates, denatured ethanol, and biodiesel. The facility presently consists of truck loading rack with VRU, barge loading dock with VRU, rail car off-loading system, multiple storage tanks, emergency generator, and miscellaneous heating sources. The proposed Title V operating permit contains all applicable regulatory requirements including monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting conditions. The permit includes requirements from 40 CFR Part 60, Subparts K and Kb; Part 60 Subparts XX and III; Part 63, Subparts BBBBBB and ZZZZ; and 40 CFR Part 64. The facility is a major source of volatile organic compounds (VOCs); and a minor source of particulate matter (PM), particulate matter <10 µm in diameter (PM10), particulate matter <2.5 µm in diameter (PM2.5), nitrogen oxides (NOX), sulfur oxides (SOX), carbon monoxide (CO), and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs), as defined in §2102.20 of Article XXI.

ALLEGHENY COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING (0960-OP23), 542 Forbes Avenue #107, PA for the renewal of a Minor Source Operating Permit for the operation of four natural-gas powered boilers that provide heat for various building including the county office building.

ELIZABETH CARBIDE DIE CO. (0434-OP23), 601 Linden Street, McKeesport, PA 15132, for the renewal of a Minor Source Operating Permit for the manufacturing of specific tools such as punches and dies that are used in the pharmaceutical industry to form pills.

VITRO FLAT GLASS, LLC - GLASS TECHNOLOGY CENTER (0116-OP23), 400 Guys Run Road, Cheswick, PA 15024 for the renewal of a Minor Source Operating Permit for an engineering, research and development facility.

UPMC PRESBYTERIAN (0224-1001a), 200 Lathrop Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15213 for the amendment to correct the minimum crematory operating temperature.

U.S. STEEL EDGAR THOMSON PLANT (0051-OP23), 13th Street and Bradock Avenue, Bradock, PA 15104, for the operation of iron and steel plant consisting of two blast furnaces and casthouses, two furnace stoves, blast furnace gas flare, basic oxygen process (BOP) shop, argon degasser, seven cooling towers and three boilers firing coke oven gas, blast furnace gas, and natural gas.
