## 2023 PAVING PROGRAM

Under this Contract, the Contractor shall furnish all materials, equipment, supplies, labor and plant required for: The 2023 Paving Program includes the removal of the asphalt or gravel surface, installation of new wearing courses, asphalt wedge curb, base repairs as needed, approximately 0.2 miles, and other work as indicated by the Contract Specifications. **In-person pick-ups will not be permitted.** Bidders must obtain bidding documents from the Issuing Office to be eligible to bid. Electronic versions of the Bidding Documents are available for the non-refundable fee of fifty-three dollars (\$53.00). Printed versions of the Bidding Documents are available for the non-refundable fee of one hundred six dollars (\$106.00) plus a non-refundable \$10.00 mailing fee. Both prices include 6% Pennsylvania Sales Tax. Checks shall be payable to "The EADS Group, Inc.". Printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office via mail delivery only. **A certified check, payable to the Owner, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and a Surety Company, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid, shall be submitted with each bid.** The Owner reserves the right to increase/decrease item quantities up to twenty percent without negotiation of unit prices in the event that budget constraints so dictate. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all of the bids, or to waive any errors, omissions, defects, or informalities, and to award the contract as may be deemed in the best interest of the Owner. The successful Bidder(s) will be required to fully **complete all work within thirty (30) calendar days** as indicated by the Owner in the written Notice to Proceed. Attention is called to the fact that no less than the minimum salaries and wages set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project; that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, age, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap.
