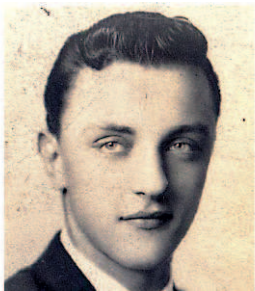


# NICHOLAS L. KLASNICK



Of Plum, on September 2, 2023, Nicholas passed away peacefully at the age of 94.
