The Kurt J Lesker Company was operating as a transfer facility and sent any fluid for reclaim to a 3rd party processor where it was processed and returned. There was no waste generated on site. The closure application for PADEP Residual Waste General Permit# WMGR143 is for Kurt J Lesker Company Reclaim Facility located on Worthington Ave, in Jefferson Hills Borough, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. Commonwealth of Pennsylvania laws require that applicants submitting closure plans under residual waste regulations give public notice to each local municipality and county in which the permitted activity is located. The host municipality and county in which the permitted activity is located. The host municipality and the public may submit comments to the DEP within 30 days of receipt of the application during which the municipality can request to be involved in the development of the remediation and reuse plans for the site. In addition, the regulations provide for a 60-day period from receipt of the closure plan by the PADEP for the host municipality and county to recommend conditions upon, revisions to and approval or disapproval of the closure plan with specific reasons.
