

GRANT E. McLAUGHLIN



Grant E. McLaughlin, 87, died September 12, 2023, in Pittsburgh, PA. He was born on May 20th, 1936, in Johnstown to W. Harry Sr. and Ellen (Kane) McLaughlin of Dilltown, Pennsylvania. He graduated from United High School in 1954 and served three years in the U.S. Army's Army Security Agency. Grant graduated from Grove City College in 1962 where he met Joyce Ann Reed and married the love of his life on June 8,

1963 (60 years) and had two sons: Grant (Tracey) and Brian (Suzy); and six grandchildren: Collin, Sean, Gavin, Anna, Seamus, and Nolan. Grant started working at Ernst and Ernst, now EY, in 1962 and left in 1970. He founded McLaughlin & Courson, CPAs with Robert Courson. For 54 years, Grant lived in Ross Township, Pittsburgh before moving to Masonic Villages, in Sewickley, in 2022. He was an elder of Northmont Presbyterian Church and served six years on the Pittsburgh Presbytery Board of Trustees, serving as its president for one year. He was a longtime member of Shannopin Country Club, serving as treasurer and vice president. Grant was a Free and Accepted Mason, North Hills Lodge 716, a member of the Scottish Rite and the Syria Shrine, North Allegheny Charitable Organization, and Royal Order of Jesters #2 serving as both treasurer and director. Grant was preceded in death by his parents; and by his seven brothers, and sisters (W. Harry Jr., James, Margaret, Robert, Edward, Helen (Quinn), and Leola (Jones)).
