Age 72, of Miramar Beach, Florida, formerly of Monongahela, died Wednesday, September 13, 2023 in his home. He was born March 29, 1951 in New Eagle, the son of Ralph Losey, Sr. of Rostraver and the late Blanche Mellor Losey.

A 1969 graduate of Monongahela High School, Ralph was recognized as one of the area's finest rebounders and went on to play basketball for California State College.
