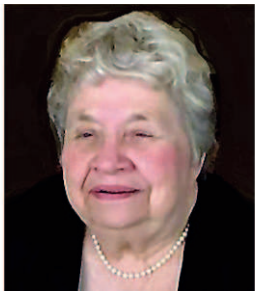


RUTH ANN (FOX) JOLL LADLEY
