The Penn Hills Zoning Hearing Board will convene its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on October 25, 2023 at 7:00 P.M. in the Penn Hills Government Center, Council Chambers, at 102 Duff Road Pittsburgh PA 15235 to consider the following **Case #34 of 2023**: Reid Greene of 22 Ridgecrest Drive, Lot and Block # 451-R-96, is requesting a dimensional variance to construct an accessory structure (shed) in the rear/side yard, at the property located at 22 Ridgecrest Drive. that would create a setback of 0' whereas 15' is required in the rear yard & 5' is required in the side yard in the R-1 Zoning District. **Case #35 of 2023**: Errol S.
