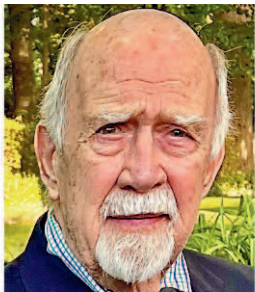


CARLTON JACK HARTMAN
