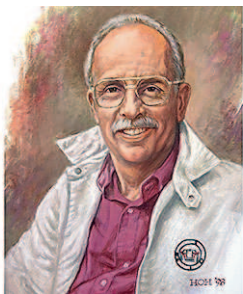


MICHAEL JOSEPH CONNOLLY

Mike's passion for automobiles and racing was also exemplified in his role in bringing the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix to life. Mike held many roles and titles with the PVGP since its inception in 1983, including Board of Directors, President of the Executive Committee, Race Director and being the 2012 recipient of the prestigious Dewey Dillinger Award from the Vintage Motorsport Council. Mike was also a lifetime member of the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) and a devoted public servant of the Bridgeville Public Parking Authority for many years.

Mike left a lasting impact on the lives of countless people. Beyond his passions for family and racing, he will be remembered for his fantastic sense of humor and clever wit, as well as for his dutiful heart that always put others' needs before his own.
