Age 87, of Mt. Washington on Saturday, October 7, 2023. Pasquale immigrated to Pittsburgh from Piaggine, Salerno (Italy) in 1954 with his father at the age of 18. He began working as a busboy and then waiter at the William Penn Hotel (at that time known as the Penn-Sheraton Hotel). Over his first few years in this country, he and his father worked to bring over other family members, and they

began their lives together in the USA. He returned to Piaggine in 1961 to marry his love, Rosa. He then settled with his family in Mt. Washington, along with many friends from his same village in Italy, building a community of paisans. He worked at Avetta Seafood and then Benkovitz Seafoods, always working a second job as a waiter, going from the William Penn to South Hills Country Club and ultimately at Sgro's Restaurant. He was preceded in death by his parents, Vincenzo and Lucia Rizzo; sisters, Angelina Sacco and Rosa Cubito; brothers-in-law, John Sacco, Carmelo Cubito, and Guiseppe Petraglia; niece, Teresa Petraglia; and nephew, Rosario Cubito. Patsy is survived by his wife, Rosa Domini; daughters, Anna (Ray) Mihalko, Donna (Mike) Palus; grandchildren, Leanna (Adam) Crowley, Anthony Palus, Emily Mihalko, R.J.
