The scope of work generally includes maintenance and repair of two stormwater management facilities within the Township of Pine including mowing, brush and shrub removal, cutting of all trees located within the ponds, removal and off-site disposal of accumulated sediment, installation of low flow channels and underdrains, installation of riprap, and seeding; and all necessary appurtenances for said construction.

Attention is directed to the fact that procurement is subject to all requirements of the Pennsylvania "Steel Products Procurement Act, Act No. 1978-3"; and for Contract value exceeding \$25,000, the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act (Act of 1961 P.L. 987), and The Public Works Employment Verification Act (July 2012) apply.
