Raymond Melnyk, age 93, of Marshall Twp., Mars, passed away on Friday afternoon, October 20, 2023, at AHN Grove City Hospital, unexpectedly of natural causes.

Born in Ambridge, PA, on November 8, 1929, he was the son of the late John and Mary Susko Melnyk. He had served in the United States Air Force Reserves.
