PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Department of Human Services (DHS) is preparing a Substantial Amendment (SA) to the County’s 2023 Annual Action Plan. This SA is being executed to adjust the allocation of 2023 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds across the four planned activities areas to allow for the expansion of resources to address homelessness. The amendment is the result of allocating other County resources to maintain operations at family shelters, allowing for ESG funds to be dedicated to street outreach, shelter operations for individuals, Rapid Rehousing and data collection activities.
