Charles Edward Goldstein, age 70, passed away on October 13, 2023. He was the son of Murray and Sara Goldstein (deceased) and leaves behind a legacy of love and compassion, survived by his wife, Caren Dana, beloved daughter, Rebecca Mariel, and sister and brother-in-law, Sandra and Jeffrey Solomon.
