Sister Mary Louise Updegraff, formerly Sister M. Janet, age 91, passed away November 3, 2023, at Vincentian Home. She attended Holy Child Jesus School in Windber, PA, and studied music at St. Joseph School in Johnstown.

Sister Mary Louise was the daughter of the late Joseph Harry Updegraff and Mary Agnes McMullen. Her five siblings (Joseph, Donald, Eugene, James and



Bernadette Ann) are deceased. She is survived by family members, including many nieces nephews and their families. A longtime friend, Carolyn Kealey, worked with Sister Mary Louise as a nurse and visited her regularly at Vincentian Home.

Sister Mary Louise entered the Sisters of St. Francis of Millvale on January 6, 1950. She was a middle school and junior high teacher in Pittsburgh and Johns before going to Puerto Rico in 1959, teaching in San Antonio and Santa Cruz until 1965. During that time, she took classes toward her undergraduate degree, as well as courses in violin. One of her students, Edgardo Daiz, came to Pittsburgh this August and had a

wonderful reunion with Sister Mary Louise. Lots of music! After returning to Pittsburgh, Sister Mary Louise obtained a BS in Music Education from Duquesne, and a Master of Fine Arts (Music Ed) from Carnegie Mellon. She continued to

teach music at Hiltop Catholic and Mt. Alvernia High Schools. In 1994, Mary Louise embarked on a new ministry in health care. She attended Alvernia School of Practical Nursing and was a practical nurse in the infirmary at Mt. Alvernia, St. Francis Medical Center and Vincentian Home. In 2009, declining health found her providing congregational service for the Community at Mt. Alvernia, including music ministry. She often played the violin for special celebrations or funerals for the Sisters.
