Sister Barbara Makar, a Sister of Charity of Nazareth, was called to her heavenly home on Friday, November 24, 2023 at the age of 93 and in the 71st year of her professed religious life at Vincentian Home after a brief illness.

Barbara was born in Greensburg, PA on January 17, 1930 to John and Antoinette (Papias) Makar. She was one of nine siblings. She was predeceased by her parents; and siblings, Julie, Steve, Katherine, Frank and Andrew. She is survived by

In 2020 when St Louise Convent closed, Barbara became a resident of Mt. Assisi Place, a personal care facility run by the Bellevue Franciscans, until shortly before her death.
