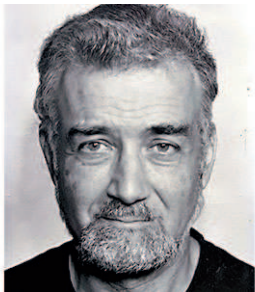


MAYER FONER



Mayer Foner, 80, of New Cumberland, PA, passed away Tuesday, November 14, 2023.

Mayer was born March 16, 1943, in Pittsburgh, PA, the son of the late Rose Kaufman and Joseph N. Foner. He graduated from Concord College and earned a Master's in Education from Penn State.
