In retirement, he dedicated himself to extensive volunteerism in the veterans community, leaving a lasting impact on the Veterans Leadership Program, Friends of Danang, and Semper Fi Outdoor Odyssey, among others.

Beyond his military and entrepreneurial pursuits, Dan was an adventurer, earning a pilot's license and cycling and playing golf around the world. Devoted to family, he cherished their Ligonier cottage and engaged in lengthy discussions with friends and neighbors on his Northside porch.

His quest for truth led him to explore various faiths, evolving from his Irish Catholic upbringing into a spiritual seeker. Following a life-altering bicycle accident, Dan formulated the acronym VAULT with his friend Harvey Young, reflecting the universal human desire to be Valued, Accepted, Understood, Loved, and Trusted. This philosophy reflects his lifelong pursuit of connection and a legacy that transcends color and creed.
