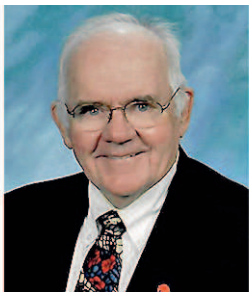


FRANCIS C. "FRANK" HYNDS
