Please take notice that Additional Defendant, Terry Shuba, Administrator of the Estate of Kacey Cohen Suba, has filed a Complaint to Join Additional Defendant against you in the aforesaid court at the above number, related to the motor vehicle accident alleged to have occurred on June 10, 2020, and the underlying civil claim filed by Plaintiff, Dennis DelVecchio, Administratrix of the Estate of Garrett Evan DelVecchio at Docket No. C-0063-cv-2021-005950. Plaintiff has demanded judgment in his favor against Original Defendant, Ryan Karmann, for an amount in excess of the jurisdictional limits of compulsory arbitration. Thereafter, Original Defendant joined Additional Defendant, Terry Shuba, Administrator of the Estate of Kasey Cohen Shuba. Additional Defendants have denied Original Defendants' claims and aver that Original Defendant and/or the Additional Defendants, including Dominick Rucker, alone are liable to the Plaintiff, jointly and/or are severally liable to Plaintiff, or liable over to this Additional Defendant for contribution and/or indemnification. You are hereby notified to file an Answer to Additional Defendant's Complaint to Join Additional Defendants within twenty days following the date of this publication. If you fail to do so, final judgment may be entered against you, as prayed for in the Complaint to Join Additional Defendants. If you wish to defend, you must enter a written Appearance personally or by an attorney and file your defenses or objections in writing with the Court. You are warned that if you fail to do so, the case may proceed without you, and a judgment may be entered against you without further notice for the relief requested by the Additional Defendant. You may lose money or other rights important to you. You should take this notice to your lawyer at once.
