Section 165 et seq. Workers shall not be paid less than the prevailing minimum wages as set forth in the applicable schedule. All bidders must submit a bid bond, in the in the amount of 10%, in the form of a certified check, bank cashier's check, or other form of negotiable instrument which is guaranteed by a commercial bank. The township reserves the right to accept or reject any form of a bid bond which, in the sole opinion of the township, does not provide sufficient security for the bid. The Township reserves the right to increase or decrease any or all quantities. No bid will be accepted after the time herein specified whether or not the bidder has a time other than the official Authority time. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.
