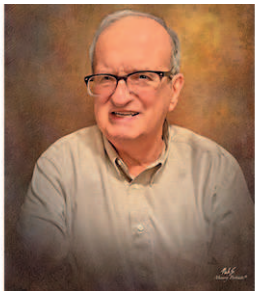


WILLIAM JAY "BILL" GLUNK
