Age 55, of Point Breeze passed away at home on December 21, 2023, after a courageous two-year battle with pancreatic cancer.

She excelled at managing and running grant programs to provide dignity and grace to under served communities.

Mila was a caring and compassionate member not only of family and friends, but of the communities she served as aide and occupational therapist. Loving mother to her two boys, she rarely missed a school event at Environmental Charter High School for Dylan or a running meet at Alderdice High School with Aran. ("Roll Dice!"). Mila was an expert in organizing vacations (beach, Colorado, California, Europe) and family activities, especially several years of Thanksgiving at Deep Creek or Seven Springs rentals. Peace, love, and kindness guided Mila's soul and rubbed off on all of those that had the pleasure of knowing her. May she rest in peace.
