Anthony J. Mazzarini Sr., "Tony," age 100, died peacefully from natural causes, at home in Holiday, FL, on Friday, December 22, 2023. He was born to Antonio Mazzarini and Firenze Persi Mazzarini on May 23, 1923 in Pittsburgh. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps upon graduation from St. Mary of the Mount High School in 1941, where he was a mechanic on B-17's for the 381st Bombing unit in World
