Age 77, of Troutville, went to be with the Lord, December 31, 2023. Billy was originally born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania to James and Beatrice Dunn on July 13, 1946, the only son of a family of six children.

Bill was a history/philosophy major in college and had a particular interest in World War II, having read and studied many books on the subject.
