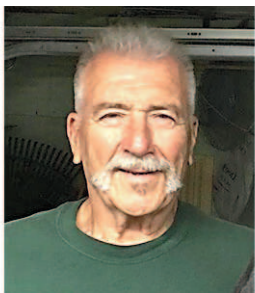


DANIEL W. "TAB" TARABRELLA



Daniel W. "Tab" Tarabrella, 76, of Elizabeth, passed away Sunday, December 17, 2023, surrounded by family in his home.

He was born May 4, 1947, in Monongahela, the son of the late William J. and Mary (Kikla) Tarabrella. Tab graduated in 1965 from the former Mon Valley Catholic High School and continued his education with football scholarships to Pratt Jr. College in Kansas and then Southern Illinois
