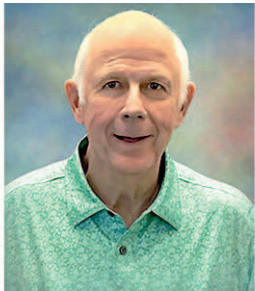


THOMAS G. "TOM" FLYNN
