

DONALD SHUCK

February 26, 1929 - January 14, 2024



Easton, MD - Donald Lockhart Shuck, age 94, died peacefully in Easton, MD, on January 14, 2024. Born in Pittsburgh, PA, he was the fourth of five children of Blanche and Edgar B. Shuck. Don was a three-sport athlete both at Langley High School and Mercersburg Academy, and went on to play baseball for Washington and Lee University, where he was a member of Delta Tau Delta. While serving as a lieutenant

in the US Marine Corps during the Korean War, Don was stationed in Japan. He returned home to his wife, Margaret "Peggy" Shafer Shuck; and his two children, Don, Jr., now of New York City, and Sally, of Stratton, VT. After working for the family business, Shafer Coachlines in Coraopolis, PA, Don became a successful stock broker with Moore Leonard & Lynch (UBS) in Pittsburgh. His wife, Peggy, died suddenly in 1967. After retiring from the brokerage business, Don relocated with his wife, Nancy Waddell Shuck, first to Pinehurst, NC, and then to Easton, MD. Don and Nancy enjoyed traveling around the world, meeting new friends in their retirement in Easton, and playing golf and bridge. They had a wonderful marriage of 48-plus years. Don was an avid reader of history, particularly the Civil War; had a keen interest in politics; and golfed until 92, shooting his age since 79. He loved spending time with his ever-growing blended family: five children, Don, Sally, Tory, Dria, and Abby; 11 grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren. All will cherish their memories of being together with Grandad at holiday celebrations, birthdays, weddings, and of course, golf outings.
