

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**  
**HAMPTON TOWNSHIP**  
**ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PA**

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Township of Hampton, 3101 McCully Road, Allison Park, PA 15101, Allegheny County, PA for the following project:

**Contract A – 2" +/- Mill and Resurface - Bituminous resurfacing of various streets in Hampton Township which includes cutting keyways at abutting roadways, 40,600 S.Y. of 2" rotomilling and profiling of existing roadway surface, 825 S.Y. of Base Repair, 40,600 S.Y. of 2" 9.5 mm Fine Graded Superpave bituminous wearing course 0.0 to 0.3 Esal's, traffic control and the necessary preparatory and cleanup work.**

**Contract B – 2" +/- Mill and Resurface - Bituminous resurfacing of various streets in Hampton Township which includes cutting keyways at abutting roadways, 7,750 S.Y. of 2" rotomilling and profiling of existing roadway surface, 200 S.Y. of Base Repair, 7,750 S.Y. of Single Seal Coat, 7,750 S.Y. of 1½" 9.5 mm Fine Graded Superpave bituminous wearing course 0.0 to 0.3 Esal's, traffic control and the necessary preparatory and cleanup work.**

**Contract C – Installation of 8,135 L.F. of Centerline Rumble Strips, Pavement Markings and Signage on South Pioneer Road including traffic control and the necessary preparatory and cleanup work. For All Contracts, Hampton Township Reserves the right to award the contract consisting of any or all roads within the scope of work. Hampton Township reserves the right to add or delete roads and/or quantities at the unit prices bid.** All proposals must be in the hands of the Township Manager, Hampton Township, 3101 McCully Road, Allison Park, PA 15101 before 10:00 a.m. prevailing time on February 20, 2024, and the same will be officially opened and read at immediately thereafter. No Bids will be accepted after 10:00 a.m. The contract will be awarded on February 28, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside with the words "2024 Contract A Paving – Various Roads", "2024 Contract B Paving – Various Roads, or 2024 Contract C – South Pioneer Road Centerline Rumble Strips and Pavement Markings. The proper title for the bid is dependent upon the bid that is submitted. All bids must be submitted in separate envelopes with the proper designation. There must be separate bid bonds submitted for each contract. One bid bond for all three contracts is not acceptable. **All bidders must be PennDOT pre-qualified as a prime contractor and meet the work classification codes of E, F, and F1. All bids submitted must have the contractor's valid pre-qualification certification attached to the outside of the bid or it will be rejected.** Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open to public inspection at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205-9401 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 per set per for each contract. Documents must be paid for before any electronic versions are distributed. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. There are no exceptions. If specifications are to be mailed, there will be an additional \$20.00 per document per contract. A document is considered one contract. Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement. **Pennsylvania Prevailing Wages apply to this project.** Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Hampton Township in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within 15 days after Notice of the Award of the Contract. If more time is necessary for the ascertainment of the lowest responsible bidder, Hampton Township reserves the right to award the contract at a later date, but not exceeding sixty (60) days from the date bids were submitted, and such date will be publicly announced by Council at their regular meeting held on February 22, 2024.
