Jessie Helene (Emerson) German, 88, peacefully passed away in the presence of family on January 26, 2024, at the Munson Hospice House in Traverse City, Michigan. Remembered for her warm heart, tender kindness, and abundant natural talents, Jessie was born in Steuben County, Indiana on May 8, 1935. Jessie was one of six siblings who grew up on an idyllic farm raising cattle and crops. President and

The proud "Gram" to two grandsons, Jessie cherished time with her family and was known as the "pet whisperer" by family and friends for the loving, gentle connection she established with animals. She had a talent for winning at games and repeatedly took top billing in her family's annual March Madness basketball pools.
