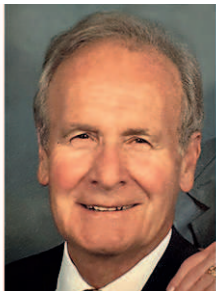


JOHN W. "JACK" SOMMER
