


EDWARD P. SUBLER



Edward P. Subler, 96, of State College, PA, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on January 19, 2024. Edward "Ed" Subler was born in Shelby, Ohio on March 24, 1927, to Dr. Leo John and Dorotha Armstrong Subler.
