We'll miss her cheerful voicemails, frequent texts, and the birthday and anniversary cards mailed early enough that the postal service just might deliver them on time. We'll carry forward her no-holdsbarred approach to April Fool's Day in honor of the creative whimsy she wove into the fabric of a life made of love,

family, and faith.
