Sealed Proposals will be received by the Municipality of Bethel Park 5100 West Library Avenue, Bethel Park, PA 15102 until 9:00 A.M. prevailing time on Tuesday, March 19, 2024 for the following project:

2024 MILLENNIUM PARK FIELD LIGHTING

This project includes the installation of sports field lighting on the multipurpose field, and lighting for the Pickleball Courts and their associated parking lot at Millennium Park.

Proposals shall be delivered in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on the outside with the words "2024 MILLENNIUM PARK FIELD LIGHTING".

Prevailing wage rates are required to be paid on this project.

Bidders are advised that this project is funded in part by a Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) Grant and that all RACP requirements must be strictly followed.

There will be a **Mandatory** Pre-bid meeting on Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at 1:00 PM on-site at Millennium Park, 5900 Baptist Road, Bethel Park, PA 15102.

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement are on file and open for public inspection between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the office of The Gateway Engineers, Inc., 100 McMorris Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205 where sets of said documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 per set. A \$15.00 fee shall be applied if documents are to be mailed. No refund will be made for the return of any documents. Electronic files may be requested at no cost.

Proposals to receive consideration must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of the Municipality of Bethel Park, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in an amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

Proposals must be made to the Municipality of Bethel Park and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw their Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting the Bid guarantee.

Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement.

Bidders are advised that the Municipality will award each contract to a single qualified, responsive, and responsible Bidder for each Contract based on the lowest Base Bid and any combination of Alternates chosen by the Municipality at its sole discretion. However, Bidders are advised that the Municipality expressly reserves the right to reject all bids, and specifically reserves the right to award to the lowest qualified, responsive, and responsible Bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each item listed and the unit price bid for each item listed.

Compliance is required with the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 19611, P.L. 987, No. 442; Title VI and other applicable provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the Department of Labor Equal Opportunity Clause (41 CFR 60 – 1.4); Executive Order 11625 (Utilization of Minority Business Enterprise); Executive Order 12138 (Utilization of Female Business Enterprise); in compliance with Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; the Allegheny County MBE/WBE Program enacted July, 1981, which sets forth goals of 13 percent Minority and 2 percent Female Business Enterprise; and the Allegheny County Ordinance #6867-12, setting forth goals of 5 percent Veteran-Owned Small Businesses.

The Municipality also reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and reserves the right to waive any informality therein.

All Proposals must be in the hands of Lou Lambros, Engineering Dept., 5100 West Library Avenue, Bethel Park, PA 15102, on or before March 19, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. prevailing time where the same will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter.
